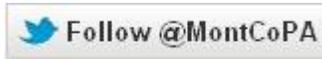

**Montgomery County Parks, Trails, and Historic Sites Hosting Free Trail Stewardship Workshop**  
**Saturday, February 20, 2016 from 8:30am to 4:30pm**

**Schwenksville, PA (February 8, 2016)** – The Montgomery County Division of Parks, Trails, and Historic Sites, in partnership with the Pennsylvania Equine Council (PEC), will be hosting a free, one-day, Trail Stewardship Workshop on Saturday, February 20, 2016 from 8:30am to 4:30pm in the classroom building at Pennypacker Mills.

Presented by the Pennsylvania Equine Council, the workshop will provide instruction on trail layout, construction, and maintenance techniques, as well as information on how to work with public land agencies. The program will offer an introduction to “Leave No Trace” skills and the “Ride Smart” concept.

All outdoor enthusiasts interested in the future of recreational access to public lands are encouraged to attend.
