

Fun with Kites at Lower Perkiomen Valley Park
Saturday, April 16, 2016 at 1:00pm

Oaks, PA (April 11, 2016) – Visit Lower Perkiomen Valley Park on Saturday, April 16, 2016 at 1:00pm for a kite making session, followed by kite flying in the fields. Participants should meet in Pavilion 1, close to the fields, for this family-friendly event.

April is National Kite Flying month, and to celebrate Lower Perkiomen Valley Park has materials available for participants to make their own high-flyers. Just in time for spring, participants can decorate and assemble their own kites, and learn the basics to make them fly successfully. The lower portion of the fields near the Perkiomen Trail is available all weekend to kite flyers. People can make a kite on site during Saturday's session or bring their own. Preregistration is required.

A materials fee of \$2.00 per kite kit is charged. Each kite kit includes a blank sail, support rods, and string. Decorating materials, like markers, will be provided. This event is for children ages five and up with a parental guide, and will be held weather permitting.
