Reptiles and Amphibians in the Backyard at Lower Perkiomen Valley Park

Oaks, PA (August 1, 2016) – Come to Lower Perkiomen Valley Park on Saturday, August 6, 2016 at 10:00am to discover the creatures in the park’s backyard! Kyle Loucks, coordinator of the southeast region of the Pennsylvania Amphibian and Reptile Survey (PARS) project will share information about reptiles and amphibians in the area. From 10:00am to 11:30am participants will listen to an educational presentation about the survey and the park’s local inhabitants. From 11:30am until noon, participants will take a break before they begin a “seek and find” hike in the park and along the Perkiomen Trail/Creek.

Participants should meet at the main pavilion/picnic area. Guests are welcomed to bring lunch to enjoy in the pavilion during the break between the classroom time and walk.
