**Cooking Workshop and Demonstration at Pottsgrove Manor**  
**Saturday, November 5, 2016 and Sunday, November 6, 2016**

**Pottstown, PA (October 24, 2016)** – Learn about colonial hospitality at historic Pottsgrove Manor on Saturday, November 5, 2016 and Sunday, November 6, 2016 during “At The Table With Mrs. Potts: A Georgian Dining Experience.”

Historic foodways expert Niel V. de Marino will be on site focusing on the foods and dining experience of a colonial household like that of the Potts family. The Saturday workshop will allow participants to prepare 18<sup>th</sup>-century dishes and the demonstration on Sunday will allow the public to see how a dinner party would have come together in the Georgian era.

The Saturday workshop runs from 10:00am to 4:00pm and is open to participants ages 14 and older. There is a fee of \$60.00 per person for the workshop. The class size is limited to 10. The Sunday demonstration runs from 1:00pm to 4:00pm and is open to the public of all ages. A \$2.00 per person donation is suggested for the demonstration. No registration is needed.

Regular museum hours are Tuesday to Saturday from 10:00am to 4:00pm and Sunday from 1:00pm to 4:00pm. Tours are given on the hour. The last tour of the day begins at 3:00pm. The site is closed Mondays and major holidays. Groups of ten or more should preregister by calling 610-326-4014.

Pottsgrove Manor is located at 100 West King Street near the intersection of King Street and Route 100, just off Route 422, in Pottstown, Pennsylvania. Pottsgrove Manor is operated by Montgomery County under the direction of the Parks, Trails, and Historic Sites Division of the Assets and

Infrastructure Department.
