- Dep. Daniel W. Gorham of Willow Grove, Pennsylvania is a former U.S. Marine Corps Vehicle Commander, Engine Specialist and Radio Operator, and a graduate of the U.S. Marine Corps School of Leadership. He is ACT 120 certified through the Municipal Police Officers' Training Academy.

“By continuing to diversifying our staff, we will keep a fresh perspective and approach to how we handle situations and solve problems,” said Kilkenny.
