Montgomery County Home & Community Service Guide
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Service Definitions

Service Definitions as defined by the Commonwealth of PA Department of Public Welfare Office of Developmental Programs.

Behavioral Support:

Services include functional assessment, development of strategies to support the individual based upon assessment, and the provision of training individuals, staff, relatives and caregivers. Completed on 1:1 basis between individual and behavior support professional with a Master's Degree or under the direction of someone with a Master's Degree.

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Companion Services:

Companion services are provided to individuals living in private homes for the limited purposes of providing supervision and assistance that is focused solely on the health and safety of the adult individual with an intellectual disability.

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Education Support Services:

Educational Support Services consist of general adult educational services including community college, university or other college-level courses, classes, or tutoring to receive a General Educational Development degree, and assistance necessary for the person to participate in apprenticeship programs.

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Habilitation:

Habilitation is a direct service (face-to-face) provided in home and community settings to assist individuals in acquiring, maintaining, and improving self-help, domestic, socialization, and adaptive skills necessary to reside successfully in home and community-based settings.

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Homemaker/Chore:

Homemaker services consist of services to enable the individual or the family member(s) or friends(s) with whom the individual resides to maintain their primary private home. Chore services consist of services needed to maintain the home in a clean, sanitary, and safe condition. This service can only be provided if neither the participant, or anyone else in the household is capable of performing and financially providing for the function; and no other relative, caregiver, landlord, community/volunteer agency, or third party payer is capable of or responsible for the provision.

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Nursing:

Nursing Services may only be funded through the Waiver if there is documentation that the service is medically necessary and not covered through Medical Assistance (MA) State Plan which includes Early Periodic Screening and Diagnostic Testing (EPSDT), Medicare and/or private insurance.

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Respite:

Respite Services are direct services that are provided to supervise and support individuals living in private homes on a short-term basis due to the absence or need for relief of those persons normally providing care.

- In Home Supports: provide individualized support for adults with developmental disability and children, helping them to set personal goals and learn the basic skills of day-to-day living. In doing so, we seek to improve care recipients' overall quality of life and support the entire family. - Life Sharing: The Life sharing program supports individuals with developmental disabilities living with qualified, trained host families. As families welcome individuals into their lives, offering support and guidance, individuals become fully participating members of their community and are empowered to reach for and achieve their goals and aspirations.

Hours of Operation: Office hours 8:30 – 4:30. Program services operate around the clock with on-call services available after hours.





Service Description:

Supported Living – Is provided throughout Montgomery County to individuals able to live in their own home or apartment without 24 hour care. Supports provided to these individuals include, but are not limited to: accompanying individuals to and from doctor's appointments, grocery shopping, budgeting and money management, housekeeping and meal preparation, recreational and leisure activities, and safety assistance/survival skills. These supports are usually provided on a one-to-one basis, but many of our supported living folks are also involved in our social group outings on Saturdays.

Home and Community Habilitation – Many of our newest individuals to the program are right out of high school, and even though they may someday be able to live independently, they are currently still living at home with family. Their outcomes focus on what skills do they still need to acquire to be able to live on their own. Many of these services will look very similar to the supports provided to SLS individuals. We utilize our ten IPADS to reinforce some of the skills being worked on while in the community. This younger group of individuals really enjoys this technology.

This service is also provided to individuals who live at home with family, but need 24 hour care, and are not really working toward being independent in a living situation. These men and women are taken by DEC staff to appropriate community events and centers of socialization and recreation where they may participate in therapeutic swimming, physical fitness programs and a wide range of social activities.

Saturday Group Activities – In Norristown (every Saturday) and Pottstown (every other Saturday), individuals are mailed or emailed a monthly schedule of activities. Individuals or family members must call in by the Wednesday prior to sign up. Some activities have a limited number that can attend so it's first come, first served. Individuals are picked up at their homes as much as possible, but on occasion some families are able to help with transportation. Activities usually cost from \$5-\$20. There is no annual membership fee. Norristown usually has from 8-15 people attending, and Pottstown is usually 4-6 depending on the interest.

Respite care is designed to provide short-term, temporary care to family members caring for their loved one so that they can have a break from their responsibilities. Respite stays can be a few days or several months depending on the needs of the family and can either be provided in the individual's home or another setting. While this form of care is often planned in advance, it is also available in crisis or emergency situations.
