Spring Cleaning Featured at the Peter Wentz Farmstead
Saturday, June 8, 2013 from 10:00am-3:00pm

Worcester, PA (June 7, 2013) – Learn about some of the basic spring chores performed during the late 18th century at the historic Peter Wentz Farmstead located off of Skippack Pike in Worcester.

The historic house will be temporarily closed for tours as it undergoes its own specialized cleaning by trained staff; however visitors will still experience many aspects of spring cleaning typical of the late 1700s. Costumed demonstrators will show the laborious task of doing laundry and general spring cleaning.
