Hands-On Fun in the Pennypacker Mills 1900s History Center

Schwenksville, PA (June 26, 2013) – Spend a weekend afternoon at historic Pennypacker Mills exploring the 1900s History Center. Visit the General Store, climb aboard the horse and buggy, and tour transportation exhibits offering insights into how people traveled. Starting Saturday, June 29, 2013 the History Center will be open on Saturdays and Sundays from 1:00pm to 4:00pm through Sunday, August 25, 2013.

Visitors will get the chance to experience how people lived in the exciting time of the early 1900s. There will be activities such as pen and ink handwriting, making a “poke” to carry dry goods, role-playing as breaker boys in a coal mine, predicting the future in one-hundred years, seeing a fully restored Rockaway carriage, and more.

Pennypacker Mills Historic Site is operated by the Montgomery County Department of Assets and Infrastructure, Division of Parks, Trails, & Historic Sites. Located at 5 Haldeman Road in Schwenksville, Montgomery County, PA, Pennypacker Mills offers year-round guided tours, changing exhibits, seasonal events, and educational programs.
