Vintage Cars at the Peter Wentz Farmstead
Saturday, November 9, 2013 from 1:00pm-4:00pm

Worcester, PA (November 5, 2013) – Enjoy classic cars? Then visit the historic Wentz Farmstead to view some restored vehicles dating from the early 20th century. Two local car clubs will be on-site from 1:00pm to 4:00pm on Saturday, November 9, 2013 to answer questions. The rain-date is the following day, Sunday, November 10, 2013 at the same time.

Members of the *North Penn Model A Ford Club* and the *Delaware Valley Region of the Antique Automobile Club of America* will showcase their lovingly restored cars and answer questions. Although these classic cars were not owned by the families who lived at the historic Wentz Farmstead during the 1920s through the 1940s, descendants of the Schultz family used an old mill building to work on their vehicles.

The event is free to the public, but a donation of \$2.00 per person is appreciated.
