Green Lane Park Hosts “Reading the Wild Signs” Walk
Saturday, February 1, 2014 at 1:00pm

Green Lane, PA (January 23, 2014) – Montgomery County’s Green Lane Park will host a program entitled “Reading the Wild Signs” on Saturday, February 1, 2014 beginning at 1:00pm.

Many of the park’s resident animals are secretive and seldom seen in daylight. Join the staff at Green Lane Park for a closer look at the signs and signatures of these wild animals including tracks, scats, and other clues they leave behind. The program will begin with a brief introduction indoors, and then participants will venture outside in search of wildlife signs. Wear sturdy waterproof boots, the ground could be snow covered or muddy.
