Green Lane Park to Host “Waterfowl Watch”
Saturday, March 15, 2014 at 1:00pm

Green Lane, PA (March 11, 2014) – Montgomery County’s Green Lane Park will hold a “Waterfowl Watch” program on Saturday, March 15, 2014 beginning at 1:00pm. Join the staff at Green Lane Park in a search for ducks, geese, swans, and other birds as they pass through the park on their annual journey north. Participants in years past have seen Greater White-fronted Geese, Tundra Swans, Northern Pintails, and Canvasbacks.

Green Lane Park was designated as an “Important Bird Area” in Pennsylvania by Pennsylvania Audubon in 1996. It is one of only 81 such areas in the Commonwealth. Grab a pair of binoculars and come on out to learn about the park’s incredibly diverse bird life.

This program is offered free of charge, and is suitable for individuals ages eight to adult. Participants should meet near the tennis courts in Green Lane Park (2298 Green Lane Road, Green Lane, PA 18054).
