“Celtic Crossroad” Summer Concert at Green Lane Park

Green Lane, PA (August 18, 2014) – #MakeItMontco moments await at Green Lane Park’s final free summer concert featuring the music of “Celtic Crossroad” on Saturday, August 23, 2014 at 7:00pm. “Celtic Crossroad” brings the music of Ireland, Scotland, and England to life through tight harmonies and powerful, intricate instrumentation on guitar, fiddle, banjo, whistle, mandolin, and bodhrán. The band performs a variety of songs from the early 20th century Irish classics, seldom heard gems that quickly become new audience favorites.
