Shapiro Convenes Meeting of County High Tech Execs

Conshohocken, PA (September 19, 2014) – Josh Shapiro, chair of the Montgomery County Commissioners, today convened an informal roundtable discussion about business and the high tech sector in the county. Shapiro and CEOs and other officials of 13 firms met for 90 minutes at the headquarters of Kynetic, a high tech company headquartered in Conshohocken.

“We had a very informative discussion this morning with tech CEOs from Montgomery County about how MC2B can help these companies grow and innovate,” Shapiro said. “I learned a lot from these business leaders about what our county government can do to help them create jobs and be even more successful.”

MC2B is a new initiative of the county’s Department of Commerce that offers local businesses a single place to obtain and access a full range of business products and services.

Over the last two years, the county has worked to develop and grow innovative ideas, expand growth opportunities, and make county government work more intelligently and effectively with local businesses. The county has placed particular focus on finding and retaining talented employees, identifying local drivers of growth for technology companies, and expanding the technology community in our County.

“As professionals in this community, we care deeply about job growth and innovation in technology companies in the region,” Shapiro said. “We recognize that the partnership between business and government is critical to this effort and ultimately thrives on an open dialogue.”
