Join the staff at Green Lane Park in a search for ducks, geese, swans, and other birds. The park is a well-known stopover for waterfowl as they begin their spring journey north. Participants in years past have seen Tundra Swans, Cackling Geese, Northern Pintails, Canvasbacks, and more. Come out and discover why Green Lane Park is designated as a Pennsylvania Important Bird Area by the National Audubon Society. Bring binoculars and meet at the Tennis Court Parking Lot located at 2298 Green Lane Road, Green Lane, PA 18054.
