### **Schuylkill Expressway Shooting**

Montgomery County District Attorney Risa Vetri Ferman and Pennsylvania State Police, Troop K, Captain James P. Raykovitz announce the arrest of Kymere E. Corbin, age 22, for a shooting that occurred inside a car on the Schuylkill Expressway (I-76) near mile-marker 332 in Montgomery County.

On Tuesday, April 7, 2015, at approximately 6:00 PM, Pennsylvania State Police responded to the scene. Investigation revealed that, at the time of the shooting, Kymere E. Corbin was the back seat passenger of a Buick LaCrosse automobile. The driver of the car was Kymere Corbin's father. The front seat passenger was Kymere Corbin's mother. The three individuals were engaged in a family argument when, at approximately 5:45 PM, Kymere E. Corbin produced a handgun and fired one shot that struck his father in the head. The victim was rushed to an area hospital for treatment of what are believed to be non-life-threatening injuries.

Kymere E. Corbin is charged with Aggravated Assault and several related charges. The defendant was arraigned by Magisterial District Judge William Maruszczak and bail was set at \$500,000. Judge Maaruszczak scheduled a preliminary hearing April 20, 2015 at 8am.
