Kennett Square Man Arrested On Multiple Bank Robberies



Montgomery County District Attorney Risa Vetri Ferman, Westmoreland County District Attorney John Peck, Lancaster County District Attorney Craig W. Stedman, Whitpain Township Police Chief Kenneth Lawson, Jenkintown Borough Police Chief Albert DiValentino, the Delaware State Police, the Federal Bureau of Investigation--Delaware, Pennsylvania State Police--Lancaster, and North Huntingdon Township Police Chief Andrew Lisiecki announce the arrest of Joseph Mieluchowski on charges of Robbery, Conspiracy to Commit Robbery, Kidnapping, and related charges.

A joint investigation was conducted by the Montgomery County District Attorney's Office, Whitpain Township Police Department, Jenkintown Borough Police Department, the Delaware State Police, and the FBI--Delaware into a series of bank robberies that occurred in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania and the state of Delaware.

As a result of this joint effort, Joseph Mieluchowski is charged with the armed robbery of three banks in Montgomery County:

- 5/12/2010 -The Citizens Bank, 48 W. Skippack Pike, Whitpain Township, Pennsylvania.
- 6/26/2010 -The Royal Bank, 600 York Road, Jenkintown
- 2/5/2012 -The Citizens Bank, 48 W. Skippack Pike, Whitpain Township, Pennsylvania.

This investigation also revealed that Mieluchowski committed two additional armed robberies in Pennsylvania:

- 11/18/2009- The PNC Bank located at 8931 Route 30 in North Huntingdon, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania.
- 5/27/2011- The Susquehanna Bank located at 790 Route 41 in Gap, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania.

By agreement of all of the involved jurisdictions, Mieluchowski will be prosecuted in Montgomery County for all of these robberies. The Defendant was arraigned before Magisterial District Judge Robert Sobeck. Bail was set at \$1,000,000. A preliminary hearing is scheduled for June 23, 2015 before Judge Sobeck.

The case will be prosecuted in Montgomery County by Assistant District Attorney Gabriel C. Magee.
