Schwenksville, PA (November 2, 2015) – When guests were invited for dinner at the Pennypackers' home 100 years ago, the mansion was lit by kerosene lamps and candles. A soft glow lit each room where people gathered and as soon as they left, the lights were extinguished. This was the way of life for everyone in those early years of the twentieth century.
