THREE ARRESTED FOR APRIL 2015 MURDER OF KEITHON MAJORS IN NORRISTOWN

NORRISTOWN, Pa.—Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Norristown Police Chief Mark E. Talbot, Sr. announce the arrests of Kevin Slocum, age 21, Terrell Slocum, age 23 and Diandre Brown, age 22, for murder and related offenses. The charges are a result of an investigation into the April 6, 2015, homicide death of Keithon Majors, age 30, which occurred in the 1200 block of Locust Street in Norristown.

On Monday, April 6, 2015 at 8:52 p.m., Norristown Police responded to the area of Locust and Basin streets for a report of shots fired. Officers observed broken glass in the 1200 block of Locust Street. At 9:03 p.m., a Plymouth Township Police Officer located gunshot victim Keithon Majors inside a vehicle in the Lukoil service station at 603 Ridge Pike in Plymouth Township. Majors was transported to Mercy Suburban Hospital where he was pronounced dead at 10:37 p.m. The investigation revealed that Majors was shot in the 1200 block of Locust Street in Norristown.

Kevin Slocum, Terrell Slocum and Diandre Brown were arraigned by District Judge Elizabeth McHugh and remanded to the Montgomery County Correctional Facility. A preliminary hearing was set for 9:30 a.m., March 28, 2016 before District Judge Margaret Hunsicker.

The case will be prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Gabriel Magee and James Price.
