DA STEELE, REP. VEREB, FAMILY ANNOUNCE THE DECLINE OF RAFAEL ROBB'S PAROLE REQUEST

NORRISTOWN, Pa. – Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele announced today that convicted killer Rafael Robb is expected to serve his entire 10-year sentence after the parole board refused his early release.

Steele joined with Rep. Mike Vereb, Upper Merion Police Chief Thomas Nolan, Ellen Gregory Robb's brother Gary Gregory, PA Victim Advocate Jennifer Storm and Attorney Robert Mongeluzzi in making the announcement. Robb is not expected to be released until 2017, and after he is released, he will be on 10 years of supervised probation.

"The District Attorney's Office is dedicated to achieving justice and protecting the safety of our community. Justice was served by declining this inmate's request for an early release and keeping Rafael Robb behind bars until 2017," said Steele.
