VICTIMS IDENTIFIED IN THE AMBLER DOUBLE HOMICIDE

NORRISTOWN, Pa.—Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Ambler Borough Police Chief William F. Foley, Jr. announce the joint investigation into a double-murder in the 100 block of Forest Avenue in Ambler Borough. The deceased are Janice Trunk, 54, and Kevin Milton Smith, 44.

On Sunday, July 31, 2016 at 11:15 p.m., Ambler Police responded to a report of fired gunshots in the Forest Garden Apartments. Upon arrival at the complex, officers searched the various apartments for evidence of shooting. Within minutes, officers located the second-floor shooting scene and entered the apartment where, inside, they discovered the bodies of the two victims.

The Montgomery County Coroner's Office completed autopsies today and determined the causes of death for both victims were multiple gunshot wounds and the manners of death are Homicide.
