BOBBY BROWN OF NORRISTOWN ARRESTED FOR ATTEMPTED MURDER IN NOVEMBER 1ST POTTSTOWN SHOOTING



NORRISTOWN, Pa. (Nov. 28, 2106) — Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Pottstown Police Chief F. Richard Drumheller announce the arrest of Bobby Brown, 40, of Norristown, for Attempted Murder, Aggravated Assault, weapons charges and other charges related to a November 1, 2016 shooting in Pottstown.

The Pottstown Police responded to a reported shooting in a garage located at the rear of 47 King St., at approximately 2:40 p.m., where they found a man suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. He was transported to Pottstown Memorial Medical Center for treatment. An investigation by the Pottstown Police Department revealed that the defendant arrived at the garage with two other men, and after a heated discussion with the victim concerning a motorcycle parked in the garage, the defendant shot the victim several times with a silver handgun.

Brown was arraigned Saturday before Magisterial District Judge Jay S. Friedenberg, who set bail at \$250,000. Brown was remanded to the Montgomery County Correctional Facility after failing to make bail. A preliminary hearing is scheduled for 9 a.m. on Dec. 12, 2016 before Magisterial District Judge Scott T. Palladino.

The case will be prosecuted by the Community Prosecution Unit assigned to Pottstown.
