NORRISTOWN, Pa. (June 28, 2017)—Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Norristown Police Chief Mark E. Talbot announced a \$5,000 reward for any information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons who murdered 27-year-old Martinis Black in Norristown on Dec. 22, 2015.

Black was found dead at 7:15 a.m. on the 800 block of Maple Alley by Norristown Municipal Police, who were responding to a 911 call about a male lying on the ground. Black died of an apparent gunshot wound, but no other details have been released by detectives.

“Norristown Police and Montgomery County Detectives are actively working this case and are looking for help from the public,” said Steele. “Someone somewhere knows something and I hope this \$5,000 is the incentive they need to do the right thing and share what they know about the killer. We want to find Mr. Black’s murderer and bring justice to his family.”
