### **PROTESTER CHARGED WITH DISORDERLY CONDUCT OUTSIDE OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COURTHOUSE**

NORRISTOWN, Pa. (April 9, 2018) — The Montgomery County District Attorney's Office announces the charging of Nicolle Rochelle, 39, of Little Falls, N.J., with Disorderly Conduct after she entered a restricted area on the grounds of the Montgomery County Courthouse at 8:35 a.m., when the defendant, William H. Cosby Jr., was arriving for court. She was wearing no clothing from the waist up.

Rochelle was charged with summary Disorderly Conduct, Title 18, Section 5503(A4), which is defined as "the intent to cause a public inconvenience, annoyance or alarm or recklessly creating a risk thereof. The actor creates a physically offensive condition by any act which serves no legitimate purpose." If convicted, the defendant will be assessed a fine and be required to pay court costs.
