ARREST WARRANTS ISSUED FOR TWO MORE—AHMAD MOHAMMED AND DAIJON HARRISON—IN THE OCT. 23 MURDER IN POTTSTOWN

NORRISTOWN, Pa. (Oct. 29, 2021) — Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Pottstown Police Chief Mick Markovich announce that two new arrest warrants have been issued for in the Oct. 23 shooting death of 27-year-old Robert Stiles in Pottstown bringing the total to four wanted men. Warrants for 22-year-old Daijon Harrison and 16-year-old Ahmad Mohammed, both of Philadelphia, on First-Degree Murder and related charges were filed on Oct. 28, 2021. Previously, arrest warrants were issued for Samir Bentley, 20, of Philadelphia, and Eric Baker, 26, of Norristown, who are still being sought.

The murder of Stiles happened on Saturday, Oct. 23, 2021. Pottstown Police were dispatched at 8:26 p.m. to 429 E. High Street. The officer found Stiles lying on the sidewalk suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. He was transported by ambulance to Reading Hospital, where he later died of his injuries.

A joint homicide investigation was launched by Montgomery County Detectives and Pottstown Police. The homicide was captured on multiple surveillance cameras. New

video and audio showed that Stiles was being robbed. The video shows the victim was grabbed by Mohammed, who pulls him into an area in front of 429 High Street, then Bentley and Harrison approach. Harrison pulls a gun from his waistband and hands it to Bentley, who shoots Stiles three times, and he falls to the sidewalk. The three men then run to a dark-colored minivan. As the minivan pulls away, Baker is seen firing an assault rifle at the minivan as it flees.

As Stiles is lying on the sidewalk, he can be heard on the audio saying “I’m shot, I’m shot, Bro I’m shot, help me, help me, help me, help me, help me, help me, help me, help me.” He can also be seen discarding a clear plastic bag, throwing it several feet from where he is lying. This bag was later recovered at the scene and found to contain multiple ounces of marijuana.

Pottstown Police identified the Chrysler Town and Country minivan used as the getaway vehicle and discovered that it had been reported stolen in Philadelphia on Oct. 13, 2021. The investigation found that the minivan had been abandoned with a flat tire in Royersford and was towed from a location across from the Wawa store on Main Street. Wawa surveillance video showed Bentley and Mohammed entering the store at 8:50 p.m., a little more than 20 minutes after the murder, and purchased food, then left the store.

“These three men, including a juvenile with an outstanding warrant, drove a stolen vehicle to Pottstown from Philadelphia to rob Robert Stiles of marijuana and then killed him,” said DA Steele. “What they need to know is that in Montgomery County, we solve our murders, and we will find these wanted criminals and prosecute them on all charges.”

Harrison is wanted on charges of First-Degree Murder, Second-Degree Murder, Third-Degree Murder, Criminal Conspiracy, Robbery, Person Not to Possess a Firearm, Possessing an Instrument of Crime and related charges. He is a Black male; stands 5-feet, 11-inches tall; and weighs 160 pounds.

Mohammed is wanted on charges of First-Degree Murder, Second-Degree Murder, Third-Degree Murder, Criminal Conspiracy, Robbery, Person Not to Possess a Firearm, Possessing an Instrument of Crime and related charges. He is a Black male; stands 5-feet, 3-inches tall; and weighs 120 pounds.

Bentley is wanted on charges of First-Degree Murder, Third-Degree Murder, Criminal Conspiracy and Possessing an Instrument of Crime, although additional charges are being filed. He is a Black male; stands 5-feet, 8-inches tall; and weighs 130 pounds.

Baker is wanted on charges of Aggravated Assault, Person Not to Possess a Firearm and Recklessly Endangering Another Person. He is a Black male; stands 5-feet, 10-inches tall; and weighs 170 pounds.
