COLLEGEVILLE FATAL PEDESTRIAN-VEHICLE CRASH UNDER INVESTIGATION

NORRISTOWN, Pa. (Dec. 15, 2022)—Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Collegeville Borough Police Chief Bart Bucher announce an investigation into the Dec. 13, 2022 crash in Collegeville that critically injured 21-year-old Max Moliken of Collegeville, who later died of his injuries.

The crash occurred at approximately 4 p.m., Tuesday, Dec. 13, 2022. Collegeville Borough Police responded to the accident scene at Second Avenue and Park Avenue for a pedestrian-vehicle crash involving a white Nissan Rogue. Police arrived to find the victim lying in the roadway suffering from multiple, serious injuries. He was flown to Jefferson University Hospital in Philadelphia, where he was pronounced dead at 8:59 p.m., Dec. 14, 2022. The driver of the Nissan Rogue, who was not injured, remained on scene and has been cooperative with police.

The investigation, which is expected to take several weeks, is being conducted by Collegeville Borough with assistance from the Montgomery County Detective Bureau and members of the Regional Crash Reconstruction Team.
