Montgomery County Public Safety Recruiting Additional Telecommunicators

Eagleville, PA (January 24, 2013) — The Montgomery County Department of Public Safety is looking for the best to answer the call, literally, thousands of times per day.

The department is hiring 10 new telecommunicators to answer 9-1-1 calls.

The deadline to apply for this challenging and rewarding career in a dynamic and exciting environment is March 1, 2013. Testing will occur between March 4 and March 15, 2013. The interview and selection process will occur in April and May with training set to begin on June 24, 2013.

Telecommunicators were responsible for answering approximately 770,000 phone calls in 2012, and dispatched police, fire, and emergency medical services nearly 670,000 times.

Based in an internationally accredited, state-of-the-art Communications Center in Eagleville, telecommunicators have workstations with individual climate controls, fully paid training, and work on average just 173 days per year.

The Department of Public Safety provides 9-1-1 service and emergency communications support to nearly 150 public safety agencies throughout the County.
