- ◆ A MOTIVATOR
- ◆ A MENTOR OR GUIDE
- ◆ AN ADVOCATE

A CRS IS NOT...

- ◆ A SPONSOR
- ◆ A COUNSELOR
- ◆ A SPIRITUAL ADVISOR

RECOVERY SUPPORT SERVICES

- ◆ Assistance accessing various community resources (education, housing, medical, transportation, recovery supports, etc.)
- ◆ Guidance on the recovery process and recovery education
- ◆ Help with developing a Personal Recovery Plan
- ◆ Assistance in building life skills
- ◆ Telephone Recovery Support (Recovery Checkup: phone calls from a CRS)
- ◆ Introduce and Engage persons to the Recovery Community
- ◆ Provide support before, during, and after treatment
- ◆ Advocacy
- ◆ Outreach to individuals in early recovery
- ◆ Recovery Support Groups
- ◆ Referrals to case management services
