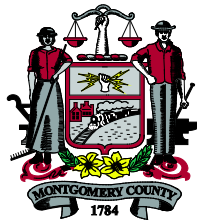

During the winter firefighters in Pennsylvania will be called to the scene of a carbon monoxide incident. Without the ability to quickly determine the nature of the incident, the first responder can become part of the problem. Topics covered include the hazards of carbon monoxide, typical carbon monoxide sources in residential occupancies, carbon monoxide detector design, and fire service monitoring equipment and suggested response and investigation procedures.
