

Pennypack Trail

Development Update: September 29, 2014

- Rails & Ties
 - all rails & ties removed from Lorimer Park North to Byberry Road
 - Byberry Road to County line Road to be removed in coming months

- Planning
 - Approvals for necessary permits to install a traffic light to provide safe vehicle access from the planned trailhead parking are secured
 - Installation of the signal will be undertaken shortly
 - All required trail construction permits are in place

- Construction North of Lorimer Park
 - The at grade SEPTA RR Crossing is nearing completion. The crossing area will remain closed until the official opening of the trail extension from Lorimer Park to Rt. 63 occurs
 - The trail surface is completed from Lorimer Park to just South of Rt. 63. The next construction item will be the actual 40+/- trailhead parking area. This construction will be occurring in early October

- Construction South of Lorimer Park
 - The 145' pedestrian bridge is in place and the required connector trail from Rockledge Borough Park and fencing will be completed the first week in October

- Trail Opening
 - A ribbon cutting will be scheduled soon. A definite date will be posted shortly. Due to ongoing construction, the trail north of Lorimer Park to Rt. 63 must remain closed until the grand opening
 - The trail connector from Rockledge Borough Park and Pedestrian Bridge will be opened when work is completed somewhere mid-October. Keep checking for the actual opening of this section
