MONTGOMERY COUNTY PROTHONOTARY TO CELEBRATE
“PASSPORT DAY IN THE USA 2014”

In order to better serve Montgomery County’s travelers, Prothonotary Mark Levy will host special office hours on Saturday, September 13, 2014.

“Our office will be open from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM as a service to the many county residents planning fall and winter travels” said Levy.

Applicants will be able to apply for a traditional Passport or a Passport Card. The Passport Card is a less expensive option that allows for travel by land between the US, Canada and Mexico as well as by sea to Bermuda and the Caribbean; it cannot be used for any air travel.

“It is a pleasure being able to offer these special Saturday hours knowing how helpful it can be to working families in the County. Making it more convenient for a family to get prepared to travel is just one example of our ongoing commitment to the County residents.” Levy commented.

Passport Day in the USA is part of an annual national program led by the US Department of State.

The Prothonotary’s passport office is regularly open weekdays from 9:00 AM to 3:30 PM at the Montgomery County Courthouse, Airy and Swede Streets, Norristown, PA 19401. The Willow Grove Annex also offers passports weekdays from 9:00 AM to 3:45 PM at 102 York Road, Suite 206, Willow Grove, PA 19090. The Willow Grove annex will not be open for Passport Day in the USA 2014.
